We would like to provide an update on the weighted assessments in Term 2.

**Assessment Weighting for 2025**

Information on the assessment weighting in 2025 for Primary 3 is provided in the table below.

Only Medical Certificates and other valid official documents are accepted for absences from Weighted Assessments (WA) and End-of-Year Examination (EYE). Kindly note that letters from parents will not be accepted and there will be no make-up assessment for absentees. Marks will not be awarded for absentees without valid documents.

If your child is absent for an assessment, his/her subject teacher will pass the assessment paper to him/her for practice. It will **not** be counted as a weighted assessment. Marks will be pro-rated for students who submit their medical certificate (MC). A mark of zero will be given for students who are absent without a reason deemed valid by the school.

Do note that your child's Form Teacher will communicate the specific assessment dates for English Language, Mathematics, Mother Tongue Language and Science via ClassDojo. As these dates vary according to individual class timetables, this will ensure you receive accurate scheduling information for your child's class.


