# Re: 2025 Primary 5 Calendar of Events for Term 2

## 1. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 2 Week 1**, CCAs starts on either **25 Mar (Tue)** or **27 Mar (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information have been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

## 2. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)
