**Re: 2025 Primary 6 Calendar of Events for Term 2**

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 6 level in Term 2.

**1. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)**

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 2 Week 1**, CCAs starts on either **25 Mar (Tue)** or **27 Mar (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information has been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

**2. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)**

The P6 ERP is conducted for **all students** after school hours starting from **Term 2 Week 1**. It aims to reinforce concepts and skills taught, extend student learning and/or bridge learning gaps, and equip students with subject-specific examination techniques. All students will come to school in their school uniform or PE attire as per normal. Various programmes will be planned for the students to help them learn about and appreciate other cultures in our cosmopolitan Singapore.

#### 5. Green Citizenship @ MPS and Earth Week

In celebration of Earth Day on **22 Apr (Tue)**, Marsiling Primary School will be commemorating Earth Week from **21 Apr (Mon) to 25 Apr (Fri)**. In alignment with the 2025 global Earth Day theme, "Our Power, Our Planet", Green Citizenship @ MPS programmes will be planned for the students to promote sustainable environmental actions that protect the environment, learn more about sustainability, and be aware of how their actions impact the environment. By providing our Marsilians with the knowledge and skills to be active green citizens and fostering a sense of agency over environmental issues, we hope to nurture tomorrow's environmental leaders. The theme "Our Power, Our Planet" focuses on renewable energy and calls for a tripling of global renewable energy generation by 2030.
