Re: 2025 Primary 3 Calendar of Events for Term 4

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participating in the activities/programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 3 level in Term 4.

1. Revision of Class Timetable

Your child would have received a new class timetable for Term 4, and it has taken effect on **15 Sep (Mon)**. Please note that the change in timetable is to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

2. Personal Grooming and Attire Check

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 4 Week 2**. Students should refer to the Student Handbook (pg. 19 to 22) for more information on school's expectations for personal grooming and attire.

3. Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 4**, CCAs start in **Week 1** on **18 Sep (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information will be provided to students by their CCA teachers.

4. Enrichment and Remedial Programme (ERP)

The Primary 3 ERP is conducted for **selected students** after school hours from **Term 4 Week**1. Consent forms have been issued to the selected students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

5. PSLE Written Examination

The PSLE Written Examination will be conducted from **25 Sep (Thu) to 1 Oct (Wed)**. All Primary 1 and Primary 2 students are required to attend school on these days. **Primary 3 to Primary 5 students** will carry out **HBL assignments at home** during the following dates. They will be assigned tasks by their subject teachers which may include activity books, revision papers and/or SLS assignments. Students should complete their assignments within this period.

The week will end on a high note with our **Children's Day Celebration** in **Term 4 Week 3**, complete with a joyful carnival and a vibrant concert! Please note that all students will be dismissed at **10.30am** on **2 Oct (Thu)**, and there will be no CCA in the afternoon. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child.

7. PSLE Marking Exercise

The annual PSLE Marking Exercise is scheduled from **13 Oct (Mon) to 15 Oct (Wed)**. Students are <u>not</u> required to attend school on these days. They will be assigned HBL tasks by their subject teachers which may include activity books, revision papers and/or SLS assignments. Students should complete their assignments within this period, and are encouraged to practise the 3Rs – Read, Revise and Relax.

Selected students will be participating in a range of enrichment programmes and bridging classes. Consent forms will be issued to these students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programmes.

8. Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Selection Exercise

Students who are shortlisted to participate in the selection exercise will be informed through the school in early October. The selection exercise will be held on **14 Oct (Tue) and 15 Oct (Wed)**. Shortlisted students who would like to participate should make themselves available on both days.

9. School Administration Day

The School Administration Day is scheduled for **7 Nov (Fri)** for teachers to process the school-based assessment results. All students are **not** required to attend school on this day.

10. Awards & Appreciation Day – AADmirable 2025

The 67th Awards & Appreciation Day – AADmirable 2025 will fall on **20 Nov (Thu)**. The event will be held in the school hall and parents of prize winners will be invited to attend the ceremony. The last day of school for Primary 1 to Primary 5 students is on **19 Nov (Wed)**. Only Primary 6 students and prize winners will need to report to school on 20 Nov (Thu) for AADmirable 2025. There is no school for all students on **21 Nov (Fri)** as the school will be having Primary 1 Orientation for the 2026 cohort.
